_____ New Member OSHA – Completion of fifteen hours new member OSHA (normal 17 minus two hours infection control) prior to response with full completion of remaining OSHA , and sustaining membership within one year of joining the VVFC. (For persons enrolled in courses such as Basic Firefighter and EMT classes). Four hours of New member OSHA (30 minutes General Hazard recognition, 30 minutes Fire station Safety, 30 minutes response safety, 30 minutes fire scene safety, 30 minutes protective clothing, 30 minutes Tool And Equipment and 60 minutes SCBA) must be obtained though VVFC Departmental training.

_____ New Member OSHA – Fast Track Firefighter (or EMS)– Completion of 4 hours (30 minutes General Hazard recognition, 30 minutes Fire station Safety, 30 minutes response safety, 30 minutes fire scene safety, 30 minutes protective clothing, 30 minutes Tool And Equipment and 60 minutes SCBA)prior to response, with full completion of remaining OSHA , sustaining and firefighter (or EMS) membership within one year of joining the VVFC.
